

Meeting 17: Bru Digital Hub, Narrow West Street, Drogheda

Friday 21st April 2023

Louth Probation Community Service team will commence clean-up work on the Chord Road Cemetery next week.

The National Coordinator of the Drug Related Intimidation and Violence Engagement (DRIVE) will host an information session in the Monasterboice Inn on the 10th May 2023. This is in response to action 3.9 of the Drogheda Report Implementation Plan and in addition to online workshops that are available nationally.

The Community Crime Impact Assessment process has commenced.

HSE CHO8 Mental Health Service Manager met with the Family Support, Children, Young People and Education subgroup and gave a comprehensive insight into mental health service provision in area. A number of follow up actions have been identified.

Collaborative youth arts projects that emerged from Drogheda Implementation Board 'Commencing the Conversation' meeting last September are taking place as part of Drogheda Arts Festival – these include Drogheda Youth Arts Festival, a partnership between Droichead Arts Centre and Boomerang Youth Café; and Pride and Picturesque, a partnership between Droichead Arts Centre, Youth Work Ireland Louth, and Foróige Cable Youth Diversion Project.

Works on the new LMETB Apprentice Training Centre have been completed and staff team are being put in place.

It was agreed that a submission from Drogheda Implementation Board will be made regarding Local Economic and Community Plans.

Letters of offer and grant agreement will be issued to successful Drogheda Implementation Board small grants applicants in coming weeks.
